YELAH 360 Scholarship Fund Program Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN

- 1. Eligibility: The YELAH 360 Scholarship Fund is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico, who are between 18 and 26 years of age, were raised in a single parent household, and are currently enrolled in a college, university or professional school within the fifty (50) United States, the District of Columbia or Puerto Rico. The YELAH 360 Scholarship Fund is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.
- 2. How to Enter: To enter, complete and submit an application form, including an essay of a minimum of 250 words and no more than 500 words answering one of the two essay prompts regarding your experience being raised in a single parent household, a transcript from your college/university/professional school, and two references. All entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. CST on May 15th. All entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned. Limit one (1) entry per entrant. Entry must be submitted in English, be entrant's original creation, be true and verifiable, created solely by entrant, with no restrictions or limitations on entrant's right to submit, or Sponsor's right to use, the entry. Entry must be 100% original and not contain third party materials subject to copyright. Entry cannot defame or invade publicity rights or privacy of any person, living or deceased, or otherwise infringe upon any person's personal or proprietary rights. Modifying, enhancing or altering a third party's pre-existing work does not qualify as entrant's original creation. Entry may not be offensive or inappropriate, as determined by judges in their sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entry it deems to be inappropriate, offensive or is not in keeping with Sponsor's image, in its sole discretion.
- 3. Judging: All eligible entries received will be judged by a panel of qualified judges on the criteria of: (1.) The compelling nature of the story and (2.) the determination of the student to not allow being raised in a single parent household to prevent him/her from attaining their education/defying the stereotypes. Winners will be contacted vial email by May 30th and will have until June 10th to accept and confirm mailing address to receive the scholarship funds. If no email response is received by June 10th, YELAH 360 will award the scholarship to another applicant. In the event of a tie, such tied entries will be re-judged by an additional "tie-breaking" judge based on the criteria set forth herein. YELAH 360 reserves the right not to award all scholarships in the event it receives an insufficient number of eligible entries that meet the minimum judging criteria, as determined by YELAH 360 in its sole discretion.
- 4. Scholarship: To be paid directly to winners. All federal, state and local taxes and any other costs and expenses not specifically stated herein as being awarded are the winners' sole responsibility. No transfer, assignment, cash redemption, or substitution of scholarship except by Sponsor who may substitute a

scholarship with one of equal or greater value, at its sole discretion. All scholarship details are at the sole discretion of the Sponsor.

5. Released Parties are not responsible for printing, typographical, technical, telephonic, computer, human, network or other errors relating to or in connection with the program, including, without limitation, errors which may occur in any program related materials, the administration of the scholarship program, the processing or judging of entries or the announcement of the scholarship; for stolen, lost, late, misdirected, inaccurate, undelivered, damaged, delayed, garbled, illegible, incomplete or postage-due entries or mail. Noncompliance with the foregoing, these official rules, Sponsor's inability to make contact with a potential winner within a reasonable time period or scholarship notification returned as non-deliverable, may result in disqualification and, at Sponsor's discretion, a runner-up may be notified.
